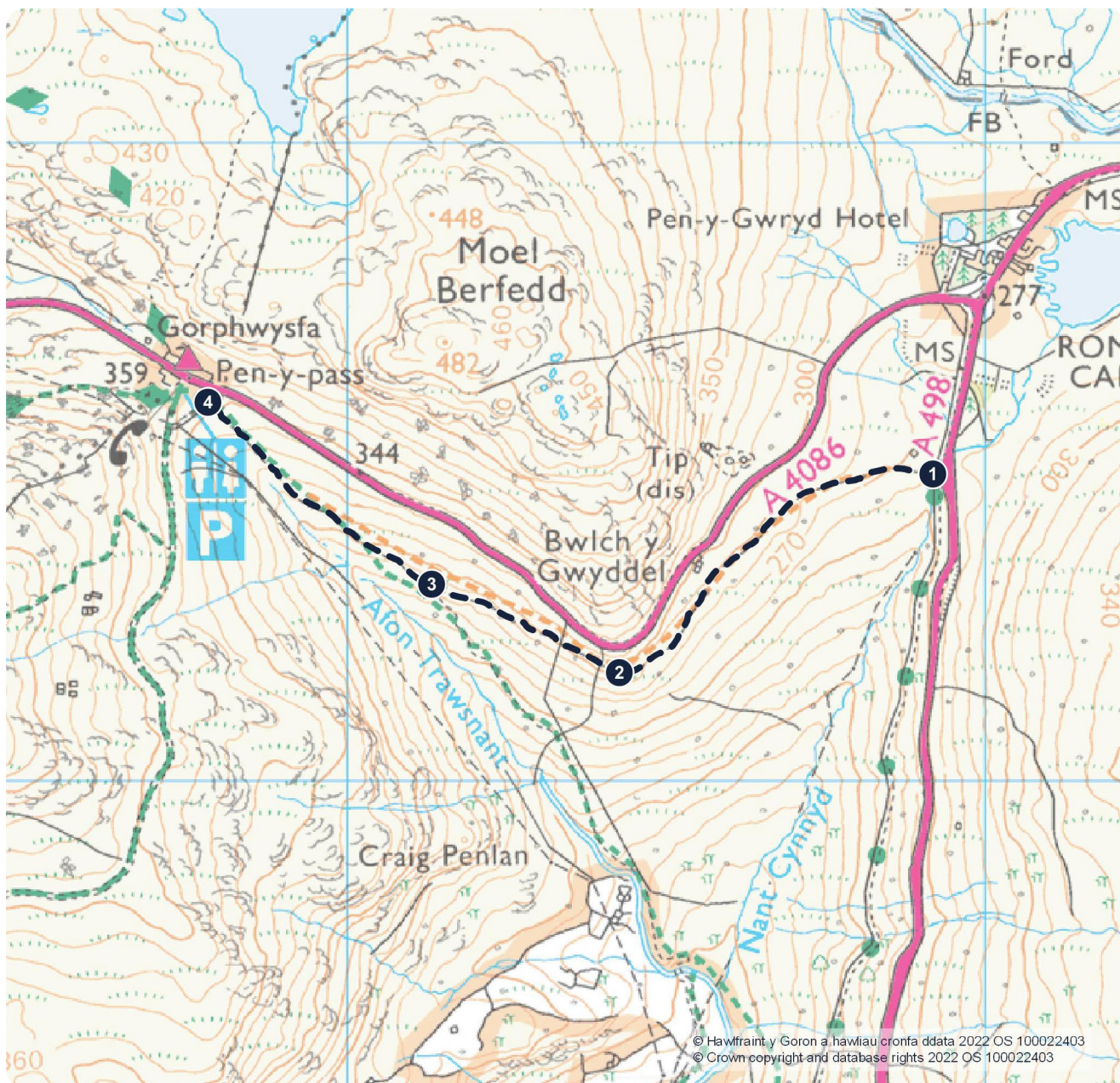




Snowdonia National Park Authority Promoted Routes

Route Overview

- Distance: 2km (1.25 miles)
- Duration: 1 hour
- Route type: There and back again

Before you start

When leaving your car, head along the right-hand side of the road towards Nant Gwynant. Go through the wooden kissing gate and bear right. Cross the wooden bridge and follow the path towards Pen y Pass.



You will soon come to a rock and some stone steps – keep walking along the path.



At the small junction, continue to the right, following the signpost for 'Pen y Pass'.



Go through the kissing gate. At this point, you could walk left to join the Miners' Track or right through the car park to join the Pyg Track.
