As part of a friendly and collaborative team volunteers you will;

- Work alongside our Warden Team to provide a warm, courteous and engaging welcome to visitors to the National Park;
- Provide advice and direct the public at Llyn Tegid Foreshore Car Park and Llangywer;
- Collect litter, when asked to do so, and help us keep the natural environment healthy and welcoming.
- Monitor and report on the condition of any access structures (e.g. gates), directional or informative signage, and interpretation panels;
- Report any wider concerns or issues (e.g. damage to the natural environment or property);
- Report any interesting wildlife sightings or interesting occurrences;
- Engage with visitors and feedback any comments to the Area Warden;
- Promote the work of the Authority and encourage the public to explore Eryri National Park.

As a Visitor Welcome Volunteer you should;

- Be willing to volunteer to engage with the public.
- Have the ability to travel to locations independently.
- Have a reasonable level of physical fitness to be able to walk the allocated patrol route.
- Have an enthusiasm for engaging with the general public.
- Have an experience of or an interest in developing monitoring and reporting skills.
- Have an enthusiasm for the National Park and have or be willing to gain knowledge of the environment, history, and places to visit.
- Be generally available on weekends and bank holidays and willing to volunteer on a reasonably regular basis.

What you can gain;

- Our thanks for being part of our team engaging and managing visitors to the National Park and monitoring critical visitor infrastructure.
- Experience with engaging the public with beautiful landscapes.
- Reasonable out of pocket expenses (vehicle mileage) will be reimbursed.
- National Park branded clothing and PPE will be supplied as appropriate.

Other relevant information;

- ENPA operates a code of conduct that all volunteers are required to adhere to.
- There are strict signing in/out arrangements for patrol duties to ensure that we can manage your health and safety. You must contact the Area Warden on duty to inform them of your movements.
- This is and outdoor based role. Volunteers should wear appropriate footwear and outdoor clothing for changeable weather conditions.
- Please make us aware of any medical conditions or special requirements so we can accommodate them.
